Meeting started at 11:15 a.m. The Chemical Hygiene Plan was distributed in the Medical Sciences Campus by the University of Puerto Rico Central Administration office in the year 2000, according to Ms. Vanessa Rodríguez, Occupational Safety officer. The Plan was developed in order to protect employees, students and visitors from exposure to hazardous chemical substances in laboratories. The document was never posted on the Intranet. The Biosafety Committee members were assigned to revise the Chemical Hygiene Plan and it was divided by pages among them, for their revision and feedback. In order to actualize the Chemical Hygene Plan, Ms. Rodríguez was invited to the meeting since the Occupational Health and Environmental Safety office (CASSO) is mentioned several times in the manual. Her knowledge of EPA policies (Environmental Protection Agency) and her status as an Occupational Safety officer is very helpful for the revision and correction of the manual.

The document was discussed by sections:

# Appendix D, Safety warnings and labels (page 35) Section II. Operational proceedings

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) website address should be added in this section, to find the safety and warning labels that are posted on the laboratories.

#### Section III. Responsibilities of the Chemical Hygiene officer (page 37)

According to OSHA, there has to be a designated Chemical Hygiene officer. At the moment the Medical Sciences Campus does not have a designated officer. It is not clear, in the absence of an officer, what measures to take. This could be verified with the Dean of Administration. It was mentioned that the Principal Investigator is responsible for the laboratory. The CHP should apply to research laboratories and teaching laboratories.

#### Section 14.3 under Medical Vigilance

Where it says "Employee Identification", eliminate Social Security Number.

#### Section 20.1 Orientation (page 18)

The orientation it's only offered to employees, this also applies for trainings. It was suggested that students should be included as well. Under OSHA regulations, students are not included. The P.I. is supposed to give students a training course before they start working in the laboratory. It was suggested that a reference note can be added, to look for the OSHA Federal Register manual, part II Department of Labor (29 CFR part 1910) where it describes the Chemical Hygiene Responsibilities.

#### Section 21.0 Maintenance of Registry and Documents (page 19)

It needs to be clarified which office is assigned to handle the records for follow up. They are divided between CASSO and the Radiation Safety office. The laboratory personnel should keep records of all areas that are stated in this section. The following were identified:

Spills and escapes- Radiation Safety office
MSDS-Laboratory and Radiation Safety office
Hazardous Materials inventories- Laboratory and Radiation Safety office
Manifests- Laboratory and Radiation Safety office
Maintenance and repairs of equipment-Laboratory
Incidents/accidents-Laboratory and Radiation Safety office.
Environmental evaluation results in the workplace-CASSO

It should be clarified which office is responsible for the remaining records. This will be verified.

#### Section 23.0 Inspections (page 20)

In this section it states that the inspections are performed each trimester. It was suggested that they should be performed twice a year instead.

#### Section 4.0 Responsibilities (page 7) Chemical Hygiene officer

A letter addressing the situation should be written. The issue will be further discussed.

#### Section 25.0 Verification of implementation (page 21)

The IBC, CASSO and the Radiation Safety office will verify that the Chemical Hygiene Plan is been followed.

#### Appendix B, Storage of Chemical substances Section B Safety Standards (page 26)

Several areas stated in this section are non applicable. It will be further discussed.

At this point it was suggested that the document should be revised by Mrs. Damarith Díaz and Ms. Vanessa Rodríguez. Because of their knowledge of the matter, they can make sure which sections of the CHP can be revised and updated. There are several compliance issues that have to be taken into consideration. Mrs. Díaz will cover the explosive materials area and Ms. Rodríguez will revise the EPA regulations. After the CHP is revised, the corrections will be presented to the Biosafety Committee for a final revision and approval, in order to be posted on the Intranet.
