I came away with a clearer idea of what is expected and the interaction that will be used to make it happen. If you have time, please convey that message to all in the Ceres group.

One item that I didn't discuss with either of you is consulting. I am working on the assumption that when you need consulting services from me that either of you (or the others that have been identified) will contact me. When contacted, it would also be helpful to me to clearly delineate (whenever possible) those tasks that are consulting as opposed to those that are considered part of our Research Agreement. Finally, if I have questions related to consulting, who is the appropriate person at Ceres to have in the loop? I assume it is either or both of you, but things do change (ie, should I work or copy Walter Nelson on this as well?).

There are many "standard" A/B lines that are used in breeding programs. Most private companies also have proprietary lines that they use.

If you ask most sorghum breeders for a set of standard and important and public inbred lines, they will identify a set of 10-20 lines that are important for the production of different types of sorghum hybrids.

A good approach to those were described in a diversity paper we published a few years back. See the reference below. There is a standard set of publicly available A/B lines in there that were characterized. Hope this helps.

## TAMU / Ceres grant team,

Here are a few documents that should help us pull together the proposal for our USDA grant for overcoming recalcitrance through sorghum breeding. In the first document I have summarized the important criteria by which this proposal will be evaluated. We should all read them and as a final review check our text against them to make certain that we have addressed all relevant criteria. There are several areas that we haven't covered at all - most obviously project management structures and evaluation criteria.

I've attached a copy of our preproposal with comments about areas that must be addressed to meet specific criteria. Please work form this document using the track changes tools in Word. Save your edits with the same core title and add your initials to help with version control. If you want to add charts or figures add the captions at the appropriate place in the text and past the figure at the end of the document. We can format and number these when the text is complete. If you have good references for any quoted values, please forward them to Tanya, who will be coordinating the technical aspects of this proposal package.

We have a unique position in this technical category as we are likely to be the only proposal addressing recalcitrance through feedstock modification. Try to highlight this in your text.

We all need to think in terms of project plans and timelines and write the expanded work plan in a way that clearly defines a well-managed project, at TAMU, Ceres and across the two organizations. The evaluation criteria seem to focus more on this, possibly reflecting an increased awareness at USDA and DOE towards project management. This will also help us translate the proposed work into the required budget categories. I have attached a copy of the budget worksheet SF424 to help us all record FTE's, equipment and travel.

I've also attached a required document concerning lobbying activities, SF-LLL.

Finally, I've attached a bio for everyone to use as a template.

This should get us started. Let me know if you have additional questions or suggestions.




