Merrelyn has found typos in three converted accessions within the sorghum association panel. Please let us know as soon as possible which number is correct.

- 1. SC 209 According to Table 1 in Casa et al. (2008), the other IDs of this accession are IS 1151C and PI 533817. We think there was a typo in the Sorghum Conversion Master List which shows SC 209 with IS 1151C as the recurrent parent and PI 291232 as the preconverted line. In the PI books as well as the ICRISAT Master list, Merrelyn found that PI 291233 is IS 1151 or Aispuri while PI 291232 is IS 1148, G4, and Guntur 4. Therefore, we believe that the description of SC 209 should have PI 291233 as the preconverted line. Do you agree?
- 2. SC 706 According to Table 1 in Casa et al. (2008), the other IDs of this accession are IS 3547C and No. 189. This doesn't match the Sorghum Conversion Master List which shows CS 706 with IS 2319 as the recurrent parent, PI 217837 as the preconverted accession, and No. 189. SC 709 (rather than SC 706) has IS 3547C as the other ID. Which is correct --- SC 706 or SC 709? If SC 706 is correct, then the secondary ID should be IS 2319C.
- 3. SC 888 According to Table 1 in Casa et al. (2008), the other ID of this accession is IS 4495C. This doesn't match the Sorghum Conversion Master List which show SC 888 with IS 5590 as the recurrent parent, but SC 868 with IS 4495 as the recurrent parent. Which is correct --- SC 888 or SC 868? If SC 888 is correct, then the secondary ID should be IS 5590C.

We want to correct these errors prior to shipping the material and perpetuating more errors in the literature. Thanks for your assistance!
